



Call for Submissions: Artist for the Breaking Bread Coloring Book

We are looking for submissions for the Breaking Bread series coloring book! The book will be given to guests who attend Threewalls' dinner and conversation series **Breaking Bread**. To be considered, submit 5 drawing samples and a proposal for the book that reflects the values of Threewalls. The final product will be a black and white publication of 10-12 pages, have an accessible, coherent visual narrative, and reflect the diversity of Chicago and its communities.

About Breaking Bread

Breaking Bread is relationship-building program that brings together a cross-section of Chicago over a prepared meal. In a casual setting, guests connect with people who are different from them by having a conversation about a question related to contemporary life and culture. Independent chefs are invited to prepare a seasonal meal and share their process, which helps to round out the experience and engagement with the culinary arts for our guests.

About Threewalls

Threewalls was founded in 2003 to provide support and visibility for the visual arts community in Chicago. The founders wanted to encourage a greater awareness of Chicago's art scene by inviting emerging professional artists to share in the city's rich histories, resources and creative communities. Over the past thirteen years, Threewalls has been a center for artist-focused programming, critical writing, and direct support for artist projects.

Today, we host artists interested in working in and with diverse Chicago communities through our RaD Lab program, support interactive work by local and regional artists in Outside the Walls, and program salons and symposiums to generate open dialogue, the presentation of new ideas, and the publication of new writing. Threewalls partners with other organizations on exhibitions, publications, and education programs in an effort to broaden and contribute to the contemporary visual arts.

Guidelines for Submission

1. Deadline to submit your artwork is **May 31, 2017**.
2. To enter a submission, submit your 5 samples of your work along with a proposal for your overall vision for the coloring book.
3. Your artwork can be any design you create. But it must reflect the vision and values of Threewalls and the essence of the Breaking Bread program.
4. We will notify you whether or not your art will be included by June 15, 2017.
5. The selected artist will receive a \$250 stipend.
6. Our goal is to print the book by July 15, 2017. The coloring book will be distributed to guests at Breaking Bread and as collateral material representing the program at public events.
